2021 Junior Membership Information

Course Access / Member Privileges

We have 2 age groups of juniors at Paragon. U13 Juniors aged 8-12 are restricted to play after 12:00pm and must be accompanied by an adult or intermediate. Special privileges can be granted with permission from our Director of Golf. U19 members do not have any playing instructions. Junior members can book 7 days in advance. Junior members are permitted to play in the men's or ladies club championships if approved by Director of Golf.

All juniors receive a learn to golf program which includes 4 hours of clinics led by Sara Wilson, PGA Director of Golf and 2016 recipient of PGA Atlantic Teacher of the Year Award. Student to Teacher Ratio 8:1

All juniors are expected to follow all club rules and follow proper golf etiquette while at the club.

Junior memberships include access to the practice putting and chipping greens.

Range memberships can be purchased for \$100 +hst

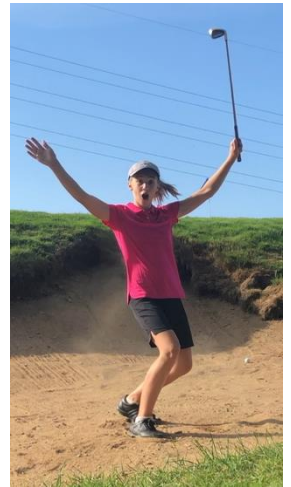

PD Day Golf Camp – June 28
